

POST-DISCOVERY HEARING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

On June 25, 2025, the Undersigned held a hearing on Plaintiffs Fanny B. Millstein and Martin Kleinbart's ("Plaintiffs") Notice of Discovery Hearing. [ECF No. 123]. At the hearing, the parties briefly discussed Plaintiffs' *ore tenus* Motion to Compel Defendant Wells Fargo Bank, N.A.'s ("Defendant" or "Wells Fargo") to produce its records custodian for deposition and to permit a certain line of questioning. [ECF No. 128]. Plaintiffs' counsel indicated to the Court that the parties are likely to reach a resolution and that it was not necessary to obtain a ruling. Therefore, the Undersigned **denies as moot** Plaintiffs' motion to compel.

However, if the parties are unable to reach a resolution, then they may schedule a discovery hearing in accordance with the Undersigned's Discovery Procedures Order. [ECF No. 38].
